## EXHIBITOR INFO 2019

### General Conditions

- The Jessup's Falls Festival is restricted to local, sustainable production and to the protection of the Natural and Cultural Heritage of the United Counties of Prescott-Russell (UCPR).
- Access is provided free of charge thanks to EscarpAction Jessup's Falls, its volunteers and sponsors.
- **Exhibitors must apply no later than June 23rd 2019.**
- Exhibition spaces will be allocated at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
- The organizers will try to accommodate exhibitors' preferences regarding location but provide no guarantee in this regard.
- The organizers reserve the right to accept or reject any application in order to ensure sufficient diversity and proper management of the space available. All registrants will be advised of their status within 5 working days from the date of their application being received.
- Registered exhibitors will be allocated a single 3m x 3m (10 ft x 10 ft) space. Larger spaces will be available only exceptionally and at the discretion of the organizers.
- Exhibitors are expected to provide their own tents, tables and chairs. There is neither electricity nor running water on the site but sanitary facilities will be provided.
- **All exhibits must be in place and all vehicles removed to the parking spaces provided at the Centre de l'Amour, 225 Rte 21 (across from the park) by 9AM Sunday, July 7th, 2019 unless specifically authorized by the organizers.**
- **Exhibitors must keep their exhibit open throughout the duration of the event (10AM to 5PM). They can break down their stand as of 5PM at which time vehicles will be allowed back on the site.**
- EscarpAction Jessup's Falls, the organizers, and South Nation Conservation, the owner of the premises, deny any responsibility for any damage or loss incurred by the exhibitors' shelters or goods.
- Exhibitors have no obligation to have a booth wholly dedicated to UCPR-related products or services. The booth is expected, however, to highlight its support for the protection of our Natural and Cultural Heritage.

- Exhibitors are invited to promote EscarpAction Jessup's Falls and their participation in the event at their place of work and in their promotion media, including their web page, Facebook page and other social networks. In exchange, the organizers, EscarpAction Jessup's Falls will reciprocate for their activities relating to Natural and Cultural Heritage.
- All exhibitors commit to be as eco-responsible as possible and to leave no trace of their presence on the site.

## **Specific Conditions for the Local Businesses Promotional Booth**

- A shared booth to promote local community organizations, businesses, artists, and artisans will be available in which participants may display business cards, menus, and promotional pamphlets.
- **Promotional materials can be dropped off with the organizers at any time before or during the Festival.**

## **Specific Conditions for the Art Gallery**

- A shared tent of 3m x 6m (10 ft x 20 ft) will be available to display original works by UCPR artists.
- **Works must be on site by 9:30AM, July 7th, and collected between 5PM and 6PM the same day.**
- Volunteers will be in the Art Gallery throughout the day but participating artists are nevertheless entirely responsible for their pieces.
- Each registered artist may show two small or one larger piece on the two large easels provided. Theme: The river and its inhabitants, above, around, and below.
- Artists whose artwork requires installation elsewhere than on the provided easels are responsible for their own installation under the direct supervision of the organizers.

**By signing the Registration Form, exhibitors participating in the Jessup's Falls Festival agree to abide by all the General Conditions as well as to any relevant Specific Conditions listed above.**
